



## BAKING DISASTER!

**Resources you will need:** 2 or 3 ingredients used for your chosen baking. Mixing bowl. Wooden spoon. Spice pot. Empty plate/cake container.

**Gestures, signs and actions:** tummy rub, peel banana, mix ingredients , signS MORE WAIT, HOT

**Sounds to make:** Opening/shutting cupboard doors, oven timer going off

**Feelings in the story:** hungry, surprise, disgust, delight

**Make it your own:** Change what child wants to make/ingredients involved/family members or pets

... indicates where the child can most easily join in

**Next chapter:** Baking success; Dinner disaster; Picnic indoors....
